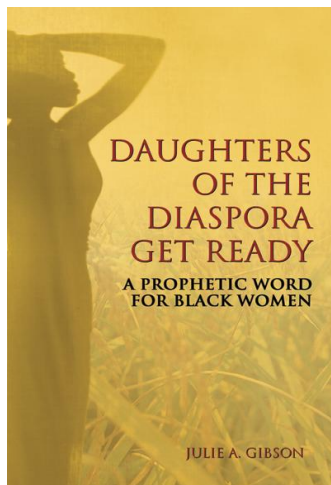

SUGGESTED INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

1. **Where did the idea for this book germinate?** It started with one word from God. He said “Issachar”. I had never heard that word before and I had no idea what it meant until I began to seek the Lord. He later turned my attention to Zephaniah 3:10 where He illuminated the prophetic destiny of the African Diaspora.

2. **What does the word “Diaspora” mean?** Diaspora simply means scattered or dispersed people groups. It’s from the Greek words “di” and “spora”, i.e. divided seed. The African Diaspora is a group of people who shared a common experience of their ancestors being taken as slaves from Africa to the Americas. African Americans, Afro-Cubans, Afro-Brazilians and Blacks in the Caribbean Islands are all part of the African Diaspora.

3. **What has been the response to the information in this book?** The book has been an eye opener for many people.
